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## The Role of Binjai Resort Police in Preventing Crime Motorcycle Gangs in Binjai City

### Abstrak

Kekhawatiran masyarakat terhadap kasus geng motor yang meningkat di Kota Binjai. Geng motor adalah sekumpulan remaja yang senang berkendara sepeda motor bersama-sama, seperti konvoi atau touring. Sebenarnya, geng motor adalah hobi yang sama dari beberapa orang, tetapi masyarakat Kota Binjai saat ini semakin resah. Penelitian ini meneliti alasan geng motor melakukan kejahatan di wilayah Kepolisian Resor Polres Binjai, dan bagaimana Kepolisian Resor Binjai menangani kejahatan geng motor di Kota Binjai. Dalam penelitian ini, yuridis empiris digunakan. Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk menjelaskan bagaimana variabel yang memengaruhi geng motor melakukan kejahatan di wilayah hukum Kepolisian Resor Polres Binjai dan bagaimana Kepolisian Resor Binjai menangani kejahatan geng motor. Data primer dan sekunder digunakan, dan analisis data kualitatif digunakan. Hasil penelitian menunjukkan bahwa beberapa faktor berkontribusi terhadap kejahatan yang dilakukan oleh geng motor di Kota Binjai pada awalnya, anggota geng motor hanya mencari identitas dan akhirnya melakukan kejahatan; faktor ekonomi, di mana pelaku geng motor mendapatkan uang untuk membeli senjata api dan narkoba. Upaya Kepolisian Resor Binjai untuk memerangi kejahatan yang dilakukan oleh geng motor mencakup upaya pidana, yang dikenal sebagai upaya penal dan upaya non-penal, yaitu upaya preventif, yaitu melakukan patroli dan razia di jalan, dan upaya pre-emptif.

## Abstract

Public concern about the increasing cases of motorcycle gangs in Binjai City. A motorcycle gang is a group of teenagers who like to ride motorcycles together, such as convoys or touring. In fact, motorcycle gangs are the same hobby of several people, but lately it has been increasingly unsettling the people of Binjai City. This study examines the reasons why motorcycle gangs commit crimes in the Binjai Police Resort Police area, and how the Binjai Resort Police handle motorcycle gang crimes in Binjai City. In this study, empirical juridical was used. This study aims to clarify the variables that allow motorcycle gangs to operate inside the Binjai Resort Police Police jurisdiction and commit crimes and how the Binjai Resort Police handle motorcycle gang crimes. Primary, secondary, and qualitative data analysis were all employed in this study. The results showed that several factors contributed to the crimes committed by the Motorcycle Gang in Binjai City., at first, the members of the Motorcycle Gang only sought identity and eventually committed the crime; economic factors, where motorcycle gang perpetrators get money to buy firearms and drugs. The efforts of the Binjai Resort Police to combat crimes committed by Motorcycle Gangs include criminal efforts, known as penal efforts, and non-penalty efforts, namely preventive efforts, namely conducting patrols and raids on the road, and pre-emptip efforts, namely providing socialization and counseling to the public about the dangers of crimes caused by the actions of Motorcycle Gang members.

## INTRODUCTION

In social life, people experience a process of intraction with each other. In this process, society faces complicated legal issues. Meeting the needs of human life is the basic goal of human association. In an effort to achieve the goal of meeting these needs, there is a possibility that similarities or even conflicts will arise with each other. In their associations, people want an orderly, peaceful, and peaceful life (Pramono, 2018). However, disputes that arise will cause chaos or unrest, perhaps even leading to anarchist actions.

Actually, the phenomenon of motorcycle gangs is not new; Almost every country has motorcycle gangs, including Indonesia, these motorcycle gangs are usually viewed negatively by the public because they are often involved in gang brawls, wild racing, looting, drug use, and various other troubles. Wild racing has grown to become one of the most common and disturbing motorcycle gang crimes. Gang members chasing on public streets must be disturbing others. In addition, it has the potential to cause accidents.

Despite the fact that motorcycles first appeared in Indonesia in 1893, brought by an English man named John Potter, there are motorcycle gangs in Indonesia. The book "De Duivelswagen" tells that Potter worked as a machinist at the Probolinggo Sugar Factory

Motorcycle Sales Procedure at Honda Dealer Pt. Sanprima Sentosa Bogor. He then ordered a motorcycle from the Hildebrand Und Wolfmuller factory in Munich, Germany, for the first time (Andrayani & Nurendah, 2013).

After that, it marked whether motorcycles appeared in Indonesia two years earlier, before motorcycles were first brought to America in 1895 by Hildebrand Und Wolfmuller. This Hildebrand Und Wolfmuller motorcycle was found in Potter's house in 1932. After that, the motorbike was repaired and stored in the Malang Museum. Moonraker Indonesia's official website says that the first motorcycle gang in Indonesia called Motorfiets Rijders Te Batavia was established in the city of Batavia, which is now known as Jakarta.

Motorcycle gang cases are becoming very common in several cities in Indonesia, including Binjai City and causing public concern. Regardless of the type, the term "motorcycle gang" refers to a group of teenagers or adults who enjoy riding motorcycles and gather to do riding activities together, such as convoys or touring (Jamaluddin, 2023). In fact, motorcycle gangs are the same hobby of several people, but lately they have been more and more unsettling to the people of Binjai City.

It is hardly known exactly what motorcycle gangs do other than committing brutal acts and what drives them to do so. Nor can we guess when, where and what it stiffens. Despite the fact that they sometimes only emit exhaust sounds, they often commit theft, street damage, and even murder (Novian et al., 2018). This has an impact on residents around Binjai City, such as fear of traveling at night and feeling unsafe when traveling, as well as other negative effects.

The problem of motorcycle gang crime is a growing regional problem and threatens national security stability, especially in Binjai City. In addition, there is a high probability that motorcycle gangs, as collections of individuals and as a form of freedom of association and assembly regulated by law, are cultized as groups that aim to cause trouble (Sambas, 2011). No matter what they have done, motorcycle gangs have never been violent.

There may be a link between juvenile delinquency and growth hormone fluctuations, which makes juvenile behavior difficult to predict, however, this is not a reason that can be used to justify juvenile behavior. The fact that hormones have such a huge effect seems to have been mitigated. It seems that there are other reasons that encourage high crime rates among adolescents and criminal acts that are very troubling to society as a whole (Ikawati, 2018).

All aspects of national and international life are regulated by law and it is expected that the law will make a significant contribution to law enforcement officials, law

enforcement officials, and all levels of society who are subject and law-abiding (Dahris Siregar et al., 2022). Violence is also caused by society's lack of control over motorcycle gang perpetrators which allows motorcycle gang crime to flourish. The use of force and violence inherent in modern adolescents, which is increasingly prevalent at night, threatens and endangers the lives of society. Based on the initial explanation in the previous section, the researcher came to conclusions on several research topics, including the factors that influence motorcycle gangs to commit crimes in the jurisdiction of the Binjai Resort Police (Polres) and how the role of the Binjai Resort Police (Polres) handles and fights the crimes that Binjai City's motorcycle gangs perpetrate.

## RESEARCH METHOD

The researcher uses an empirical juridical approach which means examining the problem by considering the applicable legal regulations and their relationship to the facts about the research subject. Researchers will investigate how the Binjai Resort Police deal with crimes committed by motorcycle gangs in Binjai City. This study uses a descriptive-analytical approach, which means that researchers provide explanations about applicable regulations relating to legal theories and positive law implementation practices related to the problem to be studied (Disemadi, 2022). Where researchers try to provide an accurate picture of how the Binjai Police handle crimes committed by Motorcycle Gangs in Binjai City. This study aims to determine the reasons why motorcycle gangs commit crimes in the jurisdiction of the Binjai Resort Police (Polres) and how the role of the Binjai Resort Police (Polres) manages crimes carried out in Binjai City by motorcycle gangs. Qualitative analysis was employed in this investigation. Qualitative analysis usually uses things like logical thinking, analysis, logic, induction, deduction, analogy, comparison and so on. Researchers will show the level of crime vulnerability of Motorcycle Gangs in the jurisdiction of Binjai Police Station. To answer the research problem, the researcher will combine the results of the analysis with this research problem.

## RESULT AND DISCUSSION

### Factors of Motorcycle Gangs Committing Crimes in the Jurisdiction of the Binjai Resort Police

Binjai City is under the control of the Binjai Resort Police (also known as Binjai Regional Police). Binjai Regional Police is included in the North Sumatra Regional Police. Binjai Regional Police has eight Sector Police (Polsek) spread across various sub-districts to

maintain regional security. Overall, the sector police under the responsibility of the Binjai Police are as follows: (1) Binjai City Police Station, (2) South Binjai Police Station, (3) West Binjai Police Station, (4) North Binjai Police Station, (5) East Binjai Police Station, (6) Completed Police Station, (7) Binjai Police Station and (8) Sei Bingai Police Station (Rasyid, 2023).

Crime is a phenomenon that cannot be eliminated, and it will continue to occur indefinitely (Habibi & Liviani, 2020). Most people believe that evil existed since the beginning of human civilization, some even believe that evil existed since the beginning of the human age. As a result, not only is it difficult to determine when evil began to appear in the world, but it is also difficult to define precise boundaries about crime. Crime as a symptom always occurs in society (crime in society) and is part of the social product of history (Christiari & Utari, 2014). In addition, crime is always associated with economic processes, which greatly affect relations between people.

Motorbike gang-related crimes are one of the more prevalent social ills in Binjai City these days. Motorcycle gangs are becoming known for committing more serious crimes, including as muggings, robberies, vandalism, molestation, and even murder, which is extremely concerning to society because they no longer merely disrupt public order by engaging in reckless racing (Maheztra, Swardhana, & Suardana, 2019). Over the past three years, motorcycle gang crime in Binjai City has increased, but it is only in 2023 that the actions of motorcycle gang perpetrators become more concerning for the community. Motorcycle gang crimes in Binjai City are generally committed by teenage children. The targets of their crimes are common people and motorcyclists, especially workers returning home at night, as well as other opposing motorcycle gang members (Fikri, 2012).

The results of research conducted by researchers at the Binjai Resort Police show that the level of vulnerability of crimes committed by motorcycle gangs, namely motor vehicle theft and violent theft, or begal is as follows:

In addition to quantitative increases, crimes committed by motorcycle gangs are also increasing qualitatively where data shows crimes committed by motorcycle gangs, both motor vehicle theft and violent theft, many people know that motorcycle gangs increase qualitative crimes, those who commit motorcycle gangs in Binjai City This is usually done by teenagers who are still in school, usually 20 years old and under, but there are no adults involved in motorcycle gangs in Binjai City. The most motorcycle gang crimes occur in the jurisdiction of the West Binjai Police Station and the least occur in the jurisdiction of the Binjai City Police Station (Bey, 2024).

There are four motorcycle groups/gangs operating in Binjai, namely RnR (Rock and Roll), SL (Simple Life), KB (Bloody Family), and west readi (Yanuar, 2024). This city has an area of vulnerability to motorcycle gang action which is quite serious. Motorcycle gangs in Binjai City are organized crime groups with leaders responsible for the planning and use of the funds they earn from their actions.

Motorcycle gang perpetrators use various means to commit their crimes in order to succeed. Modus operandi is a term used by criminals to describe how they carry out their acts. The modus operandi of evildoers has changed from the traditional and simple to the modern. It is recognized that advances in science and technology have become one of the things that encourage the modus operandi of criminal actors to develop (Emilia Susanti, 2018).

Motorcycle gang crime has also developed a modus operandi. Conventional methods such as using fake locks and damaging them, destroying ignition nest or operating machines in a more orderly manner. In addition, crimes committed by motorcycle gang perpetrators are still often committed in groups, disturbing public order and safety.

These motorcycle gangs also perform their first act by gathering together to show their identity. If the perpetrators of the motorcycle gang learn of a convoy from their opponents, they then resort to disturbances and attacks, which have an impact on society.

In addition, teenage children who walk on the street and are not members of motorcycle gangs are considered enemies of motorcycle gangs, so they are persecuted and even killed., and the purpose of these motorcycle gangs is also, which causes fights between

fellow motorcycle gangs that damage public facilities and property of local residents (Samosir, 2021).

Criminal acts committed by motorcycle gang perpetrators, including forcible seizure of motorcycle riders, additional criminal acts committed by motorcycle gang perpetrators can also be in the form (Happy Kurniawati, Purwoto, 2017):

1. Wild racing on the streets often occurs in certain areas such as on the Binjai main road, which is a danger to the safety of road users, in Waitrono Village, East Binjai District, on Jenderal Gatot Subroto, Jenderal Sudirman, Megawati, and Megawati roads.
2. Brawls between motorcycle gangs.
3. Damaging homes and public facilities.
4. Vehicle theft, mobbing, and counterfeiting of other motorcyclists at night on less congested roads.
5. To carry out decapitation, carry sharp weapons.

The results showed that the following factors encourage the criminal acts of motorcycle gang perpetrators (Rahman, 2016):

1. Factor Internal
  - a. Individual Factors

In addition, this behavior is related to needs. It is easy for a person to commit evil deeds if his needs are not balanced with their desires. Everyone has different talents and hobbies. Talent has been around since birth and is used by society to measure a person's ability to master something.

A person has unkind talents or innateness and is difficult to direct or control reasonably, they will tend to treat themselves badly, increasing their likelihood of committing crimes that harm society. In addition, people who do not have healthy hobbies or hobbies are very easily affected by negative things and easily affected by negative deeds, which is one of the causes of crime in Binjai City.

An unstable mentality also contributes to overriding behavior and a tendency to commit crimes. Those who have a mentally labile usually act without considering the consequences of their actions, their way of thinking is usually brief and depends on their emotions.

- b. Family Factors

The family forms the basic character of each person or child especially. Families that have a strong and strong character will not have negative or bad thoughts, no matter what pressures or problems they face in their lives. Problems cannot be avoided in family life

(Siregar, Sitepu, Darma, et al., 2023). Child development is greatly influenced by family life that is full of problems and does not run harmoniously, so children experience depression because their parents continue to fight and eventually divorce can cause the child's mentality to become uncontrollable, which can damage the child's mindset and lead to the child's involvement in criminal acts such as Motorcycle Gangs (Siregar, Sitepu, & Elyani, 2023).

Motorcycle gang perpetrators who continue to commit such crimes do not get proper instruction from their parents. The parents of these motorcycle gang perpetrators often show violence in their families, because they are used to seeing domestic violence, these motorcycle gang perpetrators commit crimes with violence without mercy towards the victim. In addition, parents do not supervise and pay attention to their child's development so the child tries to find identity uncontrollably. As a result, the child becomes a perpetrator of crimes that disturb society.

c. Economic factors

The difficult economic conditions in Indonesia, especially in Binjai City at the moment, there are not enough jobs for people who are supposed to work, to meet their needs is very difficult. One of the causes is the desire to make ends meet, but it is not proportional to one's economic state, this causes a person to take shortcuts by committing criminal acts to seek large profits, thus committing criminal acts.

d. Education Factors

The education factor of the perpetrator is one of the factors that cause the crime to occur. Education affects the increase in rational behavior and the reduction of irrational (emotional) behavior. The results showed that motorcycle gang members who joined and were involved in crimes in Binjai City were generally educated in junior high or high school. Because teenagers are still labile and like to imitate or follow peers or older people, many teenagers are members of motorcycle gangs and involved in crimes.

2. Factor External

a. Environmental factors

A person's social relationships in the society concerned greatly influence his evil behavior. This mainly deals with structural conditions in society. However, man may consciously choose to solve the problem of his existence by choosing a deviant path. One of the things that motivates someone to commit crimes is their surroundings. Perpetrators



of crimes can come from rich or poor families. Most crime comes from unhealthy environments.

Crime correlates with various developments in social, economic, legal life and is a social symptom that does not stand alone nor technological and other advances as a negative result of social progress or change. The crime comes from society and society itself which will bear the consequences both directly and indirectly, it is community and environmental factors that have a significant influence on someone in committing criminal acts. As a result, the search for the source of crime lies in the life of society and the environment itself.

Research conducted in Kota Binjai found that most teenagers who join motorcycle gangs and then commit crimes are influenced by friends and invitations, while most teenagers join motorcycle gangs because of their own desire to seek their existence and identity as teenagers.

#### b. Factors of Technological and Cultural Development

Crime is a social symptom, which occurs in society, with the perpetrator and victim being members of society. This crime also arises from other developments as a negative effect of progress or changes that occur in society. Today, because technology helps development, everyone has to learn to use it. Otherwise, there will be a lot of misuse of technology leading to crimes that harm society.

Movies or soap operas that are aired daily on television have a significant influence on the increase in negative behavior among adolescents. They take examples from violent acts they see in everyday life. Teenagers often imitate abusive words and sadistic acts that are often shown on television. Video games and television media also contribute to violent behavior and juvenile crime.

#### Binjai Resort Police's Role in Preventing Motorcycle Gang Crime

With so many motorcycle gang crimes happening in Binjai City, it is imperative to take concrete action to combat them. If they continue to be left unchecked, this crime will continue to grow and disturb Kamtibmas, which greatly disturbs society. Street crimes such as motorcycle gangs, which commit violent theft, illegal racing, persecution, and even damage to people's homes and public facilities, remain unresolved. The actions of motorcycle gang perpetrators are increasing and it seems increasingly difficult to eradicate. So far, the actions of these motorcycle gang perpetrators have allegedly received support and cooperate with certain individuals to strengthen their activities, as a result, within a

certain period of time, law enforcement has become unimportant to society because they cannot stop these crimes.

The police have two main tasks: prevention and prevention. Police have two main functions: prevention and pre-emptive (Esther & Sidauruk, 2018). (This effort is achieved through activities such as organizing, guarding, escorting, and patrolling, as well as the deployment of raids, which is the formula for crime (N+K). The samapta function is responsible for this prevention effort.

Based on what has been explained by the researcher above, efforts to combat motorcycle gang crime can be divided into two categories, namely (Wati & Wirasila, 2018):

1. Criminal law initiatives to stop motorcycle gangs in Binjai City from committing crimes.
2. Non-legal measures to stop illegal activity carried out by Binjai City's motorcycle gangs.

Fear of crime has not increased as a result of police policies that have only acted reactively. Because the police act reactively only after a crime has occurred. When there is a new victim, society wants the victim not to fall first but to be able to prevent crime (Mulyadi, 2007).

According to Purpura, the criminal justice system (also known as the criminal court system) is a system that includes courts, prisons, the prosecutor's office, and law enforcement. The task of law enforcers incorporated in this system is criminal law enforcement (Pujiyono, 2012). Protecting and maintaining public order, controlling crime, arresting and detaining perpetrators, and convicting perpetrators are the goals of this criminal justice system. Overall, the performance of system components is expected to protect the rights of defendants.

The motorcycle gang crime reduction policy in Binjai City allows the application of criminal law starting from the investigation and prosecution stage, also known as the pre-adjudication stage, before the case is examined and tried in court. The police have followed up the crimes committed by motorcycle gangs in Binjai City by filing a case before proceeding to the investigation and investigation stage and finally prosecuting. A criminal investigation is a sequence of steps used by investigators to identify a possible illegal conduct and assess whether further inquiry is warranted (Marbun, 2019). However, the process by which investigators look for and gather information that might clarify the illegal conduct that has place and identify the perpetrator is known as an investigation.

Once the investigation is complete and declared complete and perfect, the task of the public prosecutor shifts to filing charges and making charges based on the legal facts

revealed at trial. Then go through various stages of examination in court hearings until the judge who decides the case makes a decision. The Binjai District Court judge has sentenced the perpetrators of motorcycle gang crimes as a deterrent and guidance so that they do not commit the same mistake again after they return to society. Nevertheless, punishment will always be tougher for recidivist offenders.

The Binjai District Court judge should consider the following considerations before sentencing the defendant:

1. The courteous behavior of the defendant during the trial
2. Together uncover the true events of the defendant
3. Criminal offences committed
4. Internal concept of the defendant
5. Recidivism
6. Motivation to commit a crime
7. Education of the defendant
8. Losses suffered by victims of the crime
9. Peace

After the judge's verdict against the defendant is set, the conviction has been carried out and has permanent legal force. As executor in the case, the public prosecutor is responsible for carrying out criminal decisions. Furthermore, the penitentiary is responsible for providing guidance and guidance to the convict until he or she finishes serving his sentence.

#### Non-Penal Efforts in Handling Crimes committed by Motorcycle Gangs in Binjai City

The Binjai Resort Police uses a non-penal strategy to prevent crimes from occurring. The police have a very important task and role as they are the center of law enforcement and their success in fighting crime, including motorcycle gang crime in Binjai City. Police usually use a non-penal approach: preventive and pre-emptive.

Prevention methods used by the Binjai Resort Police include conducting patrols and raids on public roads in areas deemed vulnerable, arresting perpetrators and then bringing them to court to be punished for their actions.

The Binjai Resort police use a preemptive approach to prevent criminal acts committed by motorcycle gangs. These preemptive efforts include educating the public about the dangers posed by criminal acts committed by motorcycle gangs and providing opportunities to individuals to participate in those criminal acts.

Pre-emptive approach is the initial approach taken by the police to prevent criminal acts (Yudasena, Angkupi, & Pelangi, 2021). In tackling preemptive crime, the effort made is to instill good values and standards in a person. There will be no crime even if there is an opportunity to commit an offense or crime but there is no intention to do so. Therefore, despite opportunities, the element of intention is missing in pre-emptive efforts.

The police take pre-emptive actions to carry out their duties by providing appeals and approaches to the community to avoid the emergence of social problems and crime (Ginting & Sembiring, 2024). Persuasive communication is used to perform these pre-emptive actions, encouraging people to do things that are supposed to be done and avoid things that are prohibited by social norms and rules of society. The community development function (Binmas) is responsible for these preemptive actions. Socializing about the dangers of crime is one example of an activity carried out.

## CONCLUSION

This research reached several conclusions, one of which is that the crime rate of Motorcycle Gangs in Binjai City has increased since 2023. The modus operandi of Motorcycle Gangs has evolved from traditional to modern, using firearms in groups both during the day and at night. Internally, the causes of motorcycle gang crime consist of individual factors due to an imbalance between one's needs and wants; family factors due to lack of proper education and violence in the family; economic factors due to very difficult economic conditions while the need to meet urgent needs; and educational factors due to lack of religious education and education. On the other hand, environmental factors are influenced, with a person's environment greatly influencing their propensity to commit crimes, as well as the development of technology, culture, and social media. The Binjai Resort Police (Polres) handles crimes by making efforts to apply criminal law to perpetrators of crimes and non-penalty efforts. These include persuasive approaches, community outreach, patrols, and mapping crime-prone areas. However, during its duties, the Binjai Resort Police did not face obstacles in fighting motorcycle gang crime internally, because it has been equipped with two-wheeled and four-wheeled patrol vehicles as government facilities, and has been supported by the use of good personnel in the Polres and Polsek in the Binjai Police Jurisdiction as well as the use of information technology such as the E-Policing Application, Being one of the successful actions in crime disclosure and countermeasures as well.

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
